Summary of Program

The veterinary technician internship program is a specialized internship for veterinary technicians wanting to focus in either Anesthesia or Emergency Medicine and Critical Care. The program is designed to offer the technician the opportunity to increase knowledge and gain experience in a specific discipline.

We are accepting one intern for Anesthesia and one intern for Emergency Medicine & Critical Care. Candidates must be a graduate of an AVMA-accredited Veterinary Technology program. Experienced technicians that are credentialed (certified, registered or licensed) will also be considered.

Application Process & Deadline

Candidates are required to submit an application with a letter of interest, a resume, two letters of professional reference (DVM, Credentialed Veterinary Technician or Practice Manager) and documentation of credentials. Application packets from candidates should be received by UF College of Veterinary Medicine by March 30, 2015.

The technician will be notified of acceptance by April 20, 2015. The internship program dates are June 8, 2015- June 10, 2016. There will be core rotations, as well as elective rotations. The veterinary technician interns will be scheduled on overnight rotations, as well as weekends and holidays. Rotations will last from 1-4 weeks.
